The Fourth Judicial District Drug Task Force Control Board meeting was held on November 12, 2025.

Captain Jason French called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the above-listed members were acknowledged as present. Copies of the minutes from the October 22, 2025, meeting were distributed to all present. Sheriff Jay Cantrell made a motion, seconded by Chief Derek Wright, to accept the minutes as presented.

A copy of the financial report for Grant FY2025-2026 was distributed to all attendees for review, covering the period from July 1, 2025, to September 30, 2025. Fiscal Officer Willie Newman stated that the total expense to date was \$355,478.00, with Drug Crime Funding at \$105,280.00, Prosecutor Coordinator at \$96,856.00, Gulf Coast HIDTA at \$76,901.00, and the remaining \$ 39,380.00 being non-allowed.

Update on the city council, Willie Newman informed the board that the MOU was approved with Washington County for the fiscal year 2025, Gulf Coast HIDTA Funding. This funding will go through the end of the 2026 calendar year.

Every year, the Department of Finance and Administration does an on-site audit of the task force. They review all the files, process procedures, and the financial aspects of the task force. It was reported that everything looked good, and there were no findings.

Lieutenant Chris Moad reported on the task force's activity from October 1, 2025, through October 31, 2025,

and a copy of the statistics was distributed to all present. The task force opened 50 cases in October, closed 26, and made 11 arrests. \$11,330.00 was expended for the purchase of evidence, and \$740.00 for the purchase of information. Drugs seized during the month included methamphetamine, marijuana, cocaine, LSD, fentanyl, ecstasy, psilocybin mushrooms, and pharmaceuticals. Moad said that 18 warrants were served. The task force seized \$13,075.00 in U.S. currency and 20 firearms during the month. The locations of DTF Enforcement Action for the month were Fayetteville, 21 cases; Springdale, 20 cases; Goshen, 1 case; Washington County, 4 cases; Madison County, 2 cases; and Benton County, 2 cases. Also noted were 15 drug convictions for October.

OTHER BUSINESS

No other business was presented.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Sarah Moore, Arkansas Justice Reform Coalition.

- Moore would like to know how many individuals who are entangled with the drug task force are being placed into specialty court. The Hummingbird project has assisted 50 individuals with bonding out of the Benton and Washington County jails. Moore addressed the issue of not citing an individual from jail so they can go to treatment.

Captain Jason French requested a date and time for the next meeting. The next meeting will be on December 17, 2025, at 1:30 p.m., at the Springdale Administration Building, Community Room, 201 North Spring Ave, Springdale, Arkansas. The meeting was adjourned with a motion made by Chief Derek Wright, seconded by Sheriff Jay Cantrell.
