A special meeting of the Fayetteville City Council was held on February 08, 2011 at 5:55 p.m. in Room 326 of the City Administration Building located at 113 West Mountain Street, Fayetteville, Arkansas.

New Business:

Rock Salt for Snow and Ice Removal: An ordinance to waive competitive bidding and to approve the purchase of medium crushed rock salt for snow and ice removal.

City Attorney Kit Williams read the ordinance.

Terry Gulley, Transportation Services Director: We are not out of material yet. We started the year with about 750 tons of salt which is double what we have had in the past. We did not think we would need to purchase salt this year so we did not include it in our bulk material bid. We will obtain quotes every time we make a purchase. We are asking for you to approve the bid wavier.

Don Marr, Chief of Staff: This is a supply that does not go unused. We can carry it over to the next year.

Alderman Ferrell: When would you usually shop it during the year to build it up?

Terry Gulley: We are going to wait until the demand is not so high. It will probably be during the summer.

Alderman Ferrell moved to suspend the rules and go to the second reading. **Alderman Gray** seconded the motion. Upon roll call the motion passed 7-0. **Alderman Petty** was absent.

City Attorney Kit Williams read the ordinance.

Alderman Lewis: This changes the salinity of our streams. Out fresh water fish can not live in salt water. Keep that in mind as we purchase sweepers to clean it up.

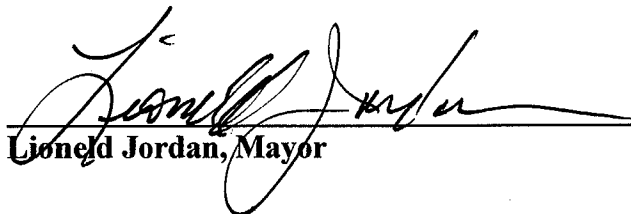
